





Human beings were made in the image of God to display the glory of God to to the ends of the earth.



Despite Israel's call to be a blessing to the world, God's people need continual rescuing from their brokenness.




JUDGES






Having a king, like the other nations, revealed that God's people need both a perfect leader as well as virtuous citizens.




In order to show them their need for restoration, God allows His people to lose their promise and experience oppression.
