to the ends of the earth.

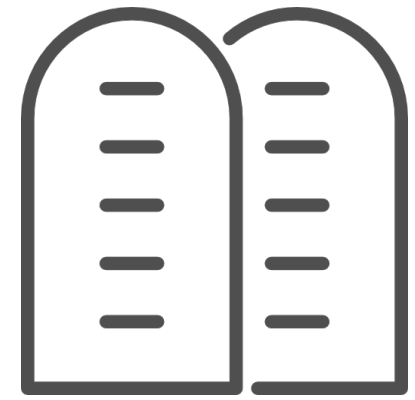

Despite Israel's call to be a blessing to the world, God's people need *continual rescuing* from their brokenness.

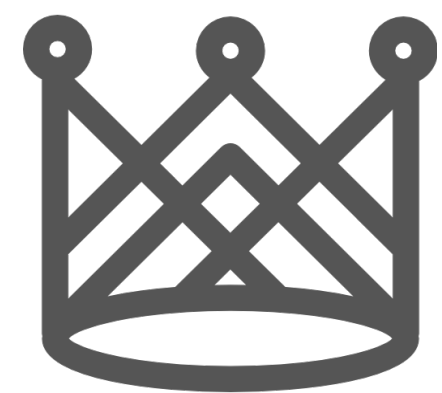

When we repent/confess our sin, God forgives and heals us. But we still have to face the *consequences of our choices.*

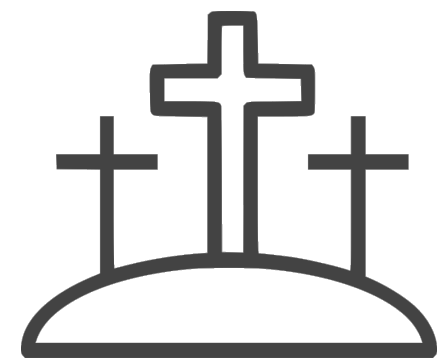

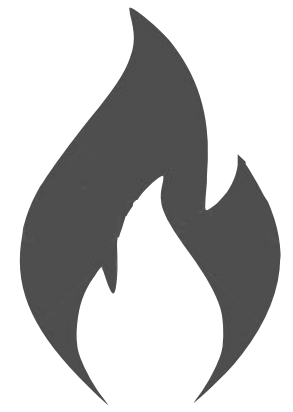


GOSPEL

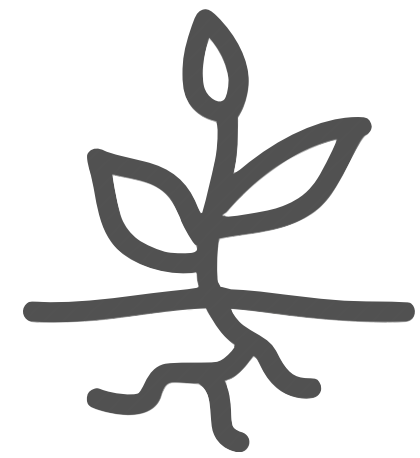

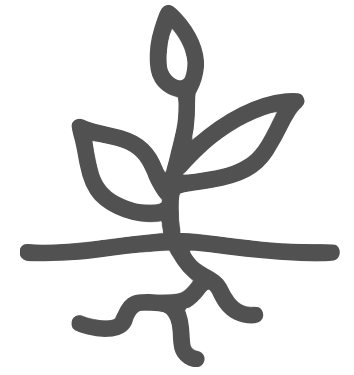
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MISSIONS

¹⁶ So from now on we regard no one from a worldly point of view. Though we once regarded Christ in this way, we do so no longer.



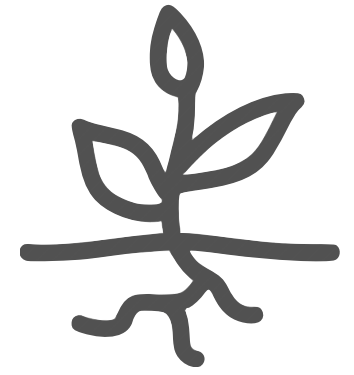
2 CORINTHIANS 5:16-6:2

¹⁷ Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!



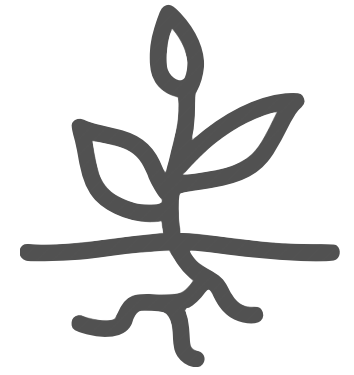
2 CORINTHIANS 5:16-6:2

of reconciliation:



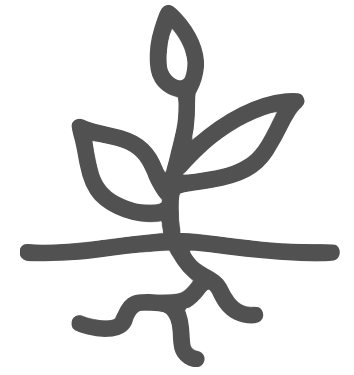
2 CORINTHIANS 5:16-6:2

¹⁹ that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation.



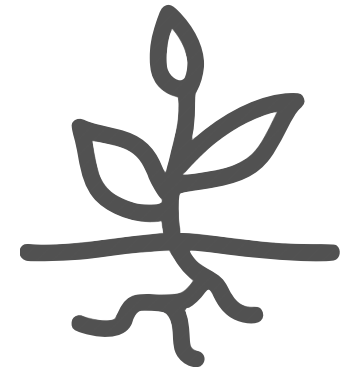
2 CORINTHIANS 5:16-6:2

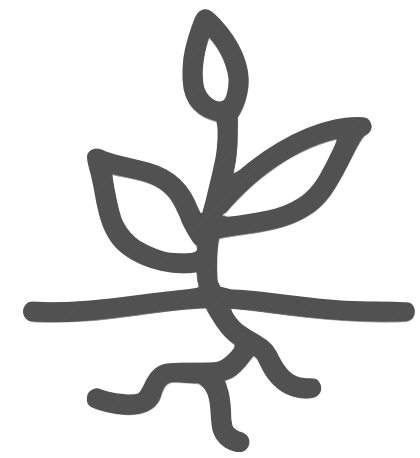

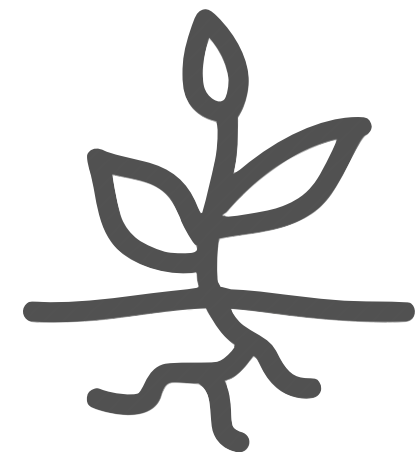

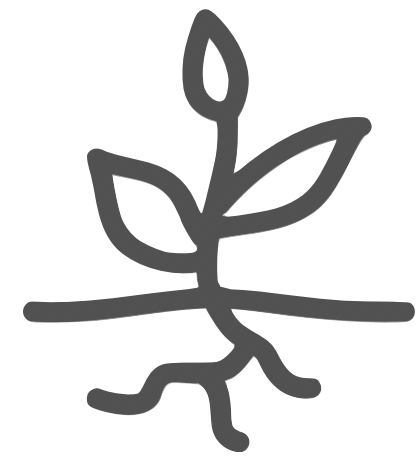


MISSIONS
