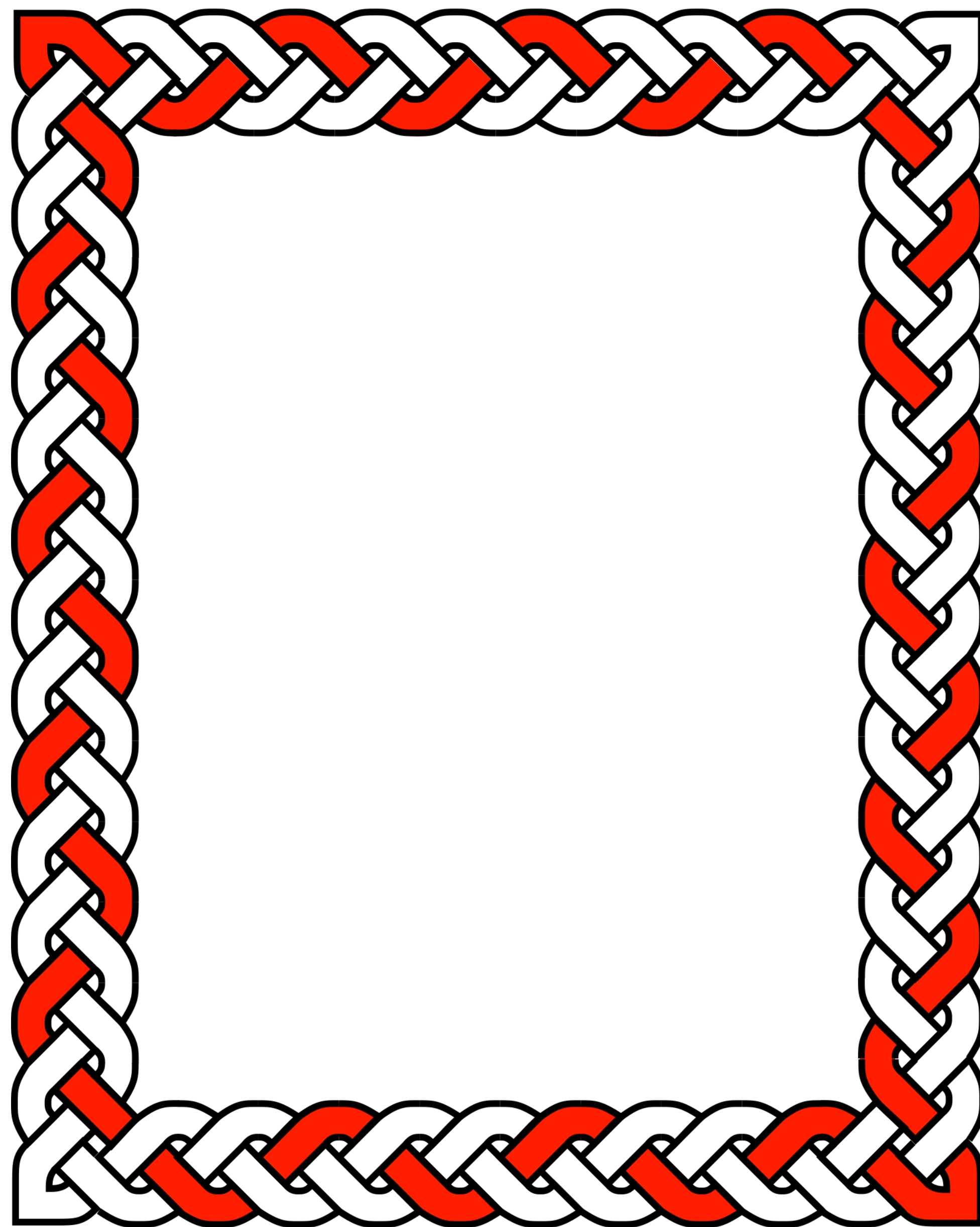

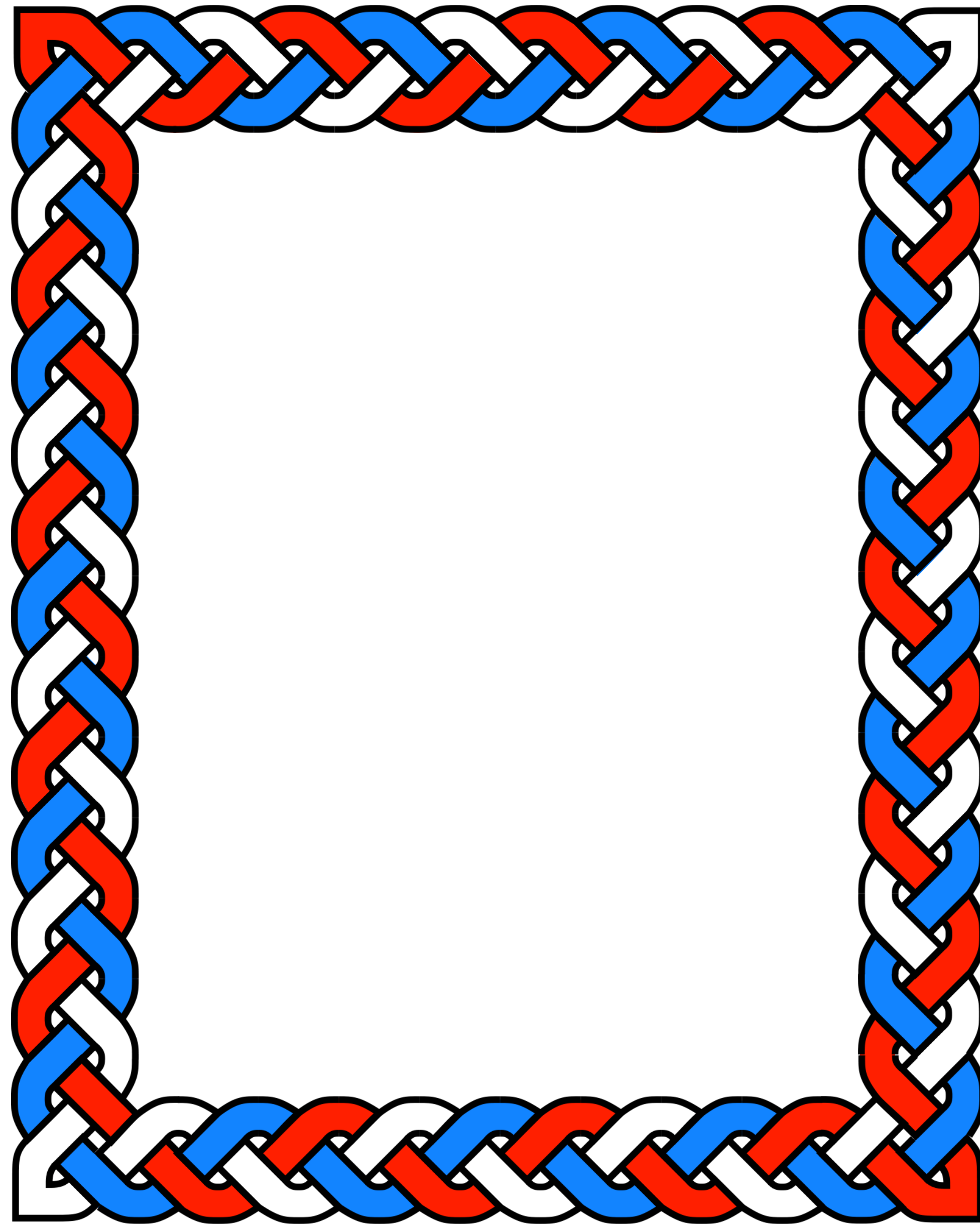

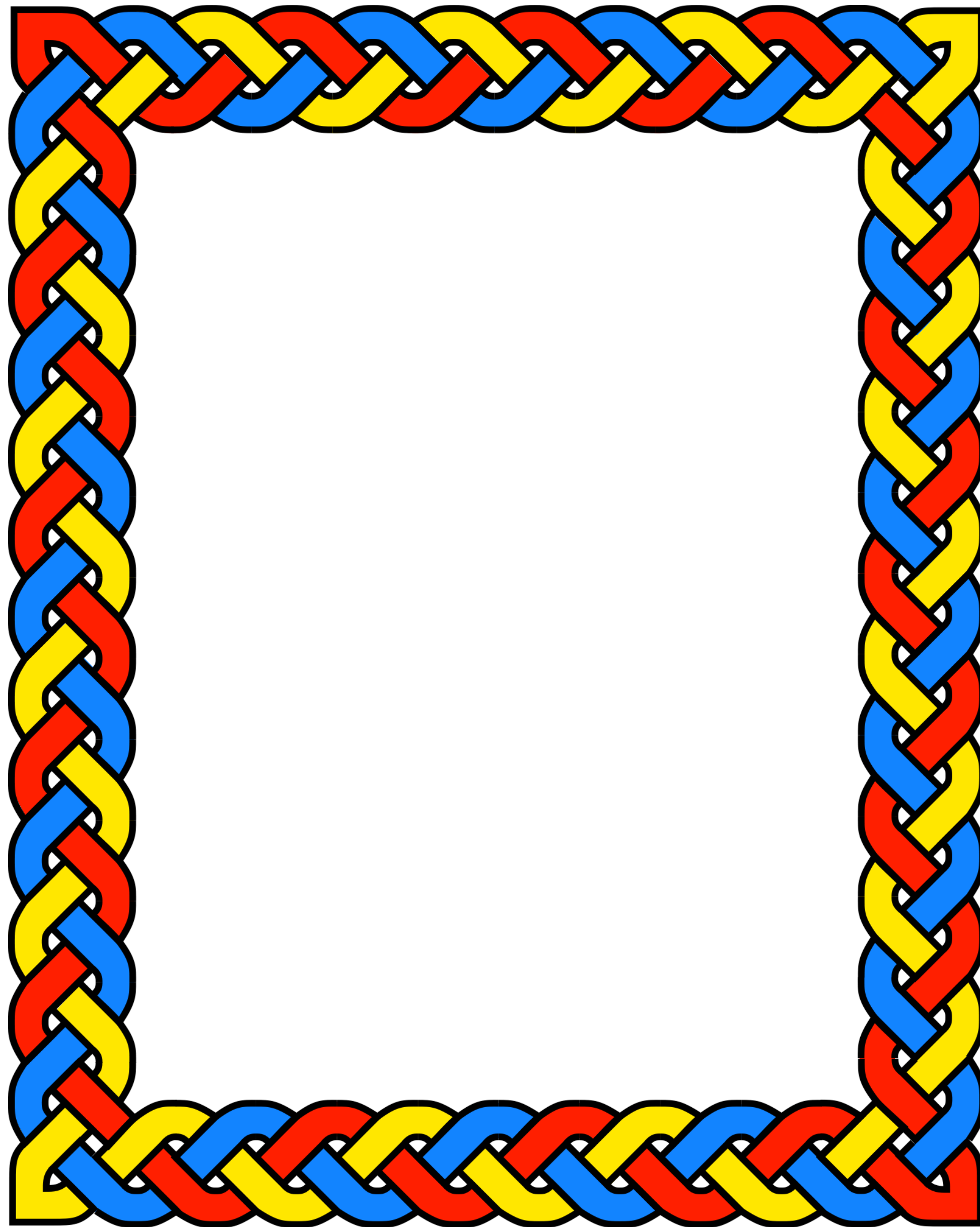
EXPRESSIVE INDIVIDUALISM

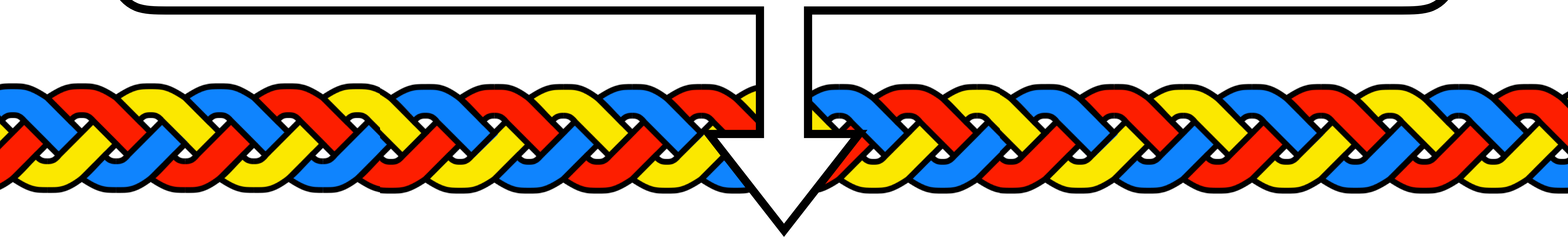
