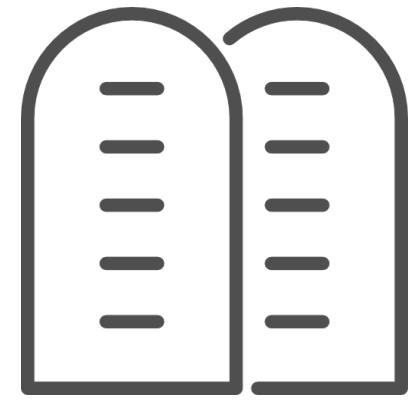

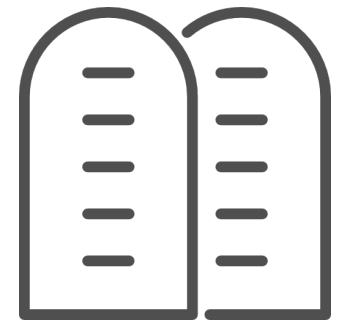

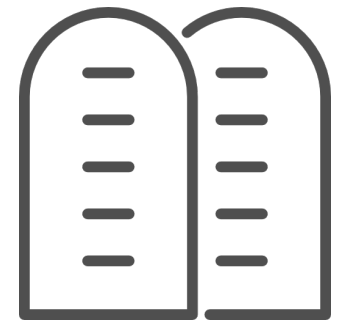
# EXODUS

As the fractured nature of humanity spreads, *competing stories* emerge to explain and justify our *selfishness*.



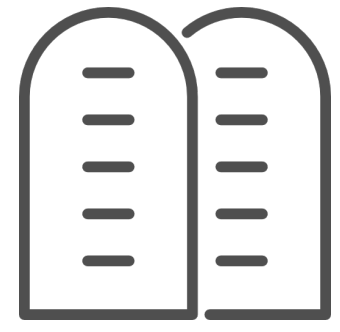
# *EXODUS 15:1-11*

2 “The Lord is my strength and my defense; he has become my salvation. He is my God, and I will praise him, my father’s God, and I will exalt him.

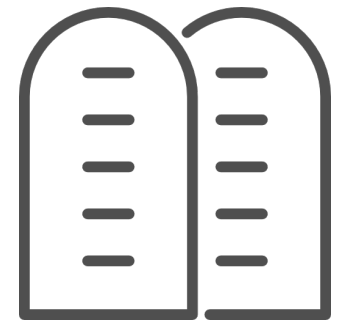

the Lord is his name.

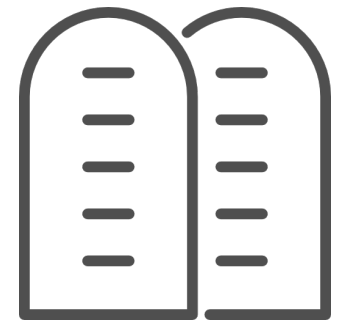
<sup>4</sup> Pharaoh's chariots and his army

are drowned in the Red Sea.





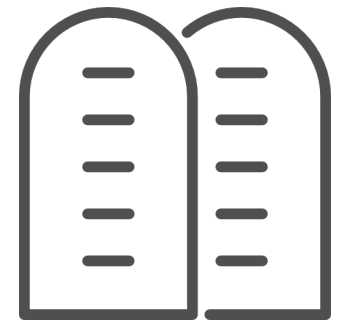
# *EXODUS 15:1-11*

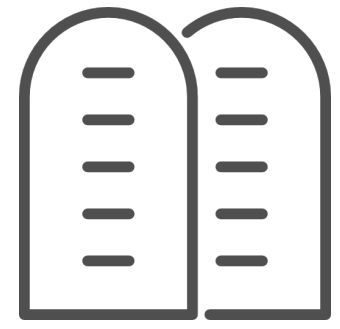
## ***EXODUS 15:1-11***

'I will pursue, I will overtake them.

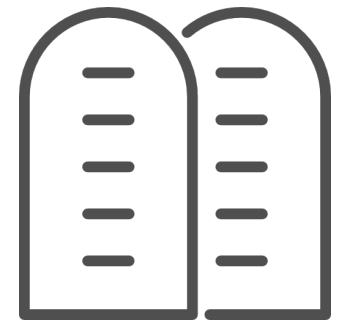
I will divide the spoils;

in the mighty waters.

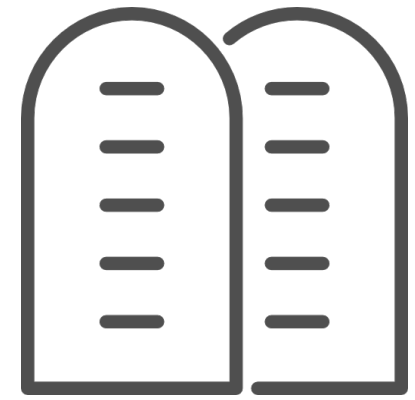

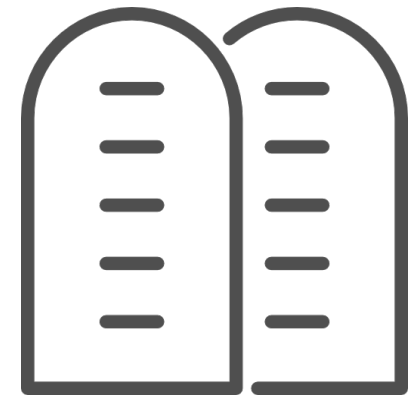


# EXODUS

The most powerful lies are the one's *hidden in half-truths*. Counterfeits thrive where *obvious competition fails*.



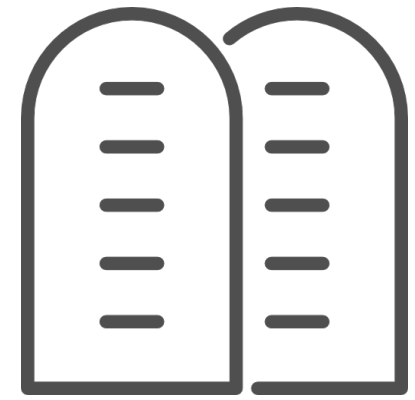

Because we were meant for more than this world's brokenness, humanity longs for *perfection that never comes.*

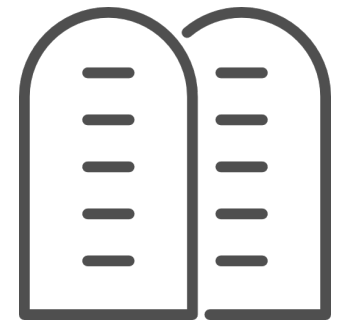

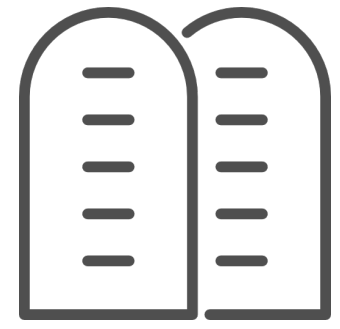
Despite Israel's call to be a blessing to the world, God's people need *continual rescuing* from their brokenness.





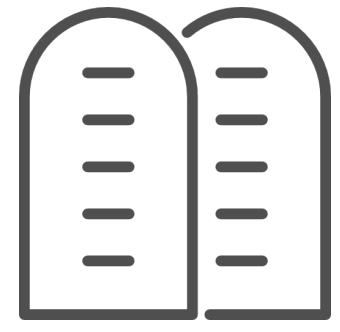
## *EXODUS 16:1-3*

<sup>2</sup> In the desert the whole community grumbled against Moses and Aaron.

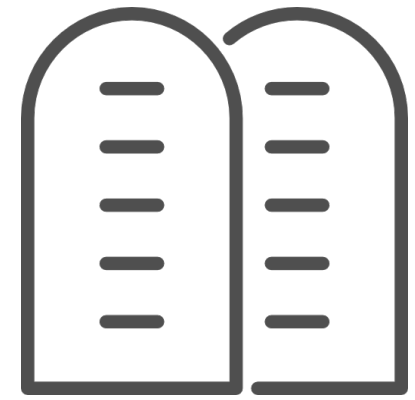


## *EXODUS 16:1-3*
