

[1] You have searched me, Lord, and You know me. [2] You know when I sit and when I rise; You perceive my thoughts from afar. [5] You hem me in behind and before, and You lay Your hand upon me. [6] Such knowledge is too wonderful for me, too lofty for me to attain.

[7] Where can I go from Your Spirit? Where can I flee from Your presence? [8] If I go up to the heavens, You are there; if I make my bed in the depths, You are there. [9] If I rise on the wings of the dawn, if I settle on the far side of the sea, [10] even there Your hand will guide me, Your right hand will hold me fast.

[11] If I say, "Surely the darkness will hide me and the light become night around me," [12] even the darkness will not be dark to You; the night will shine like the day, for darkness is as light to You. [13] For You created my inmost being; You knit me together in my mother's womb. [14] I praise You because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Your works are wonderful, I know that full well.
