


# JOHN 6:15-24

Jesus, knowing that they intended to come and make him king by force, withdrew again to a mountain by himself. When evening came, his disciples went down to the lake, where they got into a boat and set off across the lake for Capernaum.

# JOHN 6:15-24

By now it was dark, and Jesus had not yet joined them. A strong wind was blowing and the waters grew rough. When they had rowed about three or four miles, they saw Jesus approaching the boat, walking on the water; and they were frightened.

But he said to them, “It is I; don’t be afraid.” Then they were willing to take him into the boat, and immediately the boat reached the shore where they were heading.

The next day the crowd that had stayed on the opposite shore of the lake realized that only one boat had been there, and that Jesus had not entered it with his disciples, but that they had gone away alone.

- Eliminate all screens for personal use & entertainment

  - Distraction: All social media, youtube, games, news, shopping
- Turn Off All Notifications Besides Text & Call
- Screen time is limited to:
  - Work Apps on Work Devices during Work Hours
- Set Fasting Windows for Screen Time at home

- Screen free Saturdays
- Social Media Fast
- Silence when driving
