LEVITICUS 18:1-5

The Lord said to Moses, "Speak to the Israelites and say to them: 'I am the Lord your God. You must not do as they do in Egypt, where you used to live, and you must not do as they do in the land of Canaan, where I am bringing you.

LEVITICUS 18:1-5

Do not follow their practices. You must obey my laws and be careful to follow my decrees. I am the Lord your God. Keep my decrees and laws, for the person who obeys them will live by them. I am the Lord.

LEVITICUS 18:6,19-23

No one is to approach any close relative to have sexual relations. I am the Lord...

Do not approach a woman to have sexual relations during the uncleanness of her monthly period.

LEVITICUS 18:6,19-23

Do not have sexual relations with your neighbor's wife and defile yourself with her. Do not give any of your children to be sacrificed to Molek, for you must not profane the name of your God. I am the Lord.

LEVITICUS 18:6,19-23

Do not have sexual relations with a man as one does with a woman; that is detestable. Do not have sexual relations with an animal and defile yourself with it. A woman must not present herself to an animal to have sexual relations with it; that is a perversion.


THE SEXUAL ETHIC IN LEV. 18





"Then neither do I condemn you," Jesus declared. "Go now and leave your life of sin."
