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# MARK 10:32-45

They were on their way up to Jerusalem,  
with Jesus leading the way, and the  
disciples were astonished, while those  
who followed were afraid.





# MARK 10:32-45



Again he took the Twelve aside and told them what was going to happen to him. “We are going up to Jerusalem,” he said, “and the Son of Man will be delivered over to the chief priests and the teachers of the law.





# MARK 10:32-45



They will condemn him to death and will hand him over to the Gentiles, who will mock him and spit on him, flog him and kill him. Three days later he will rise.”





# MARK 10:32-45

Then James and John, the sons of Zebedee, came to him. "Teacher," they said, "we want you to do for us whatever we ask."







# MARK 10:32-45

“What do you want me to do for you?”  
he asked.

They replied, “Let one of us sit at your right  
and the other at your left in your glory.”





# MARK 10:32-45

“You don’t know what you are asking,” Jesus said. “Can you drink the cup I drink or be baptized with the baptism I am baptized with?”

“We can,” they answered.









# MARK 10:32-45



Jesus said to them, “You will drink the cup I drink and be baptized with the baptism I am baptized with, but to sit at my right or left is not for me to grant. These places belong to those for whom they have been prepared.”





# MARK 10:32-45



When the ten heard about this, they became indignant with James and John. Jesus called them together and said, "You know that those who are regarded as rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and their high officials exercise authority over them.





# MARK 10:32-45

Not so with you. Instead, whoever wants to become great among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first must be slave of all. For even the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give his life as a ransom for many.”
